Importantly, you should bring with you your own account or narrative of the facts and circumstances of your injuries and the impact that those injuries have had and continue to have on your daily life, your employment and your family.

Following your case assessment, we will discuss the prospects of bringing this matter into suit or negotiation with the responsible party or parties. If we and you elect to pursue the matter further, retainer arrangements will also be discussed. Under prevailing court rules, we become your attorneys in an accepted case once a retainer agreement is executed. We will discuss this procedure with you in your meeting with the attorney.

Other Litigation Consultation

Not all litigation involves serious personal injuries. In many cases other forms of civil controversy may occasion the need for legal assistance. These might involve construction matters, boundary disputes, commercial claims or other issues which confront individuals and their businesses every day. Many of these disputes can be resolved by negotiation with opposing parties. We frequently undertake those types of dispute resolution efforts on behalf of our clients. Some of these controversies cannot be resolved in a less formal way and result in court action being required.
